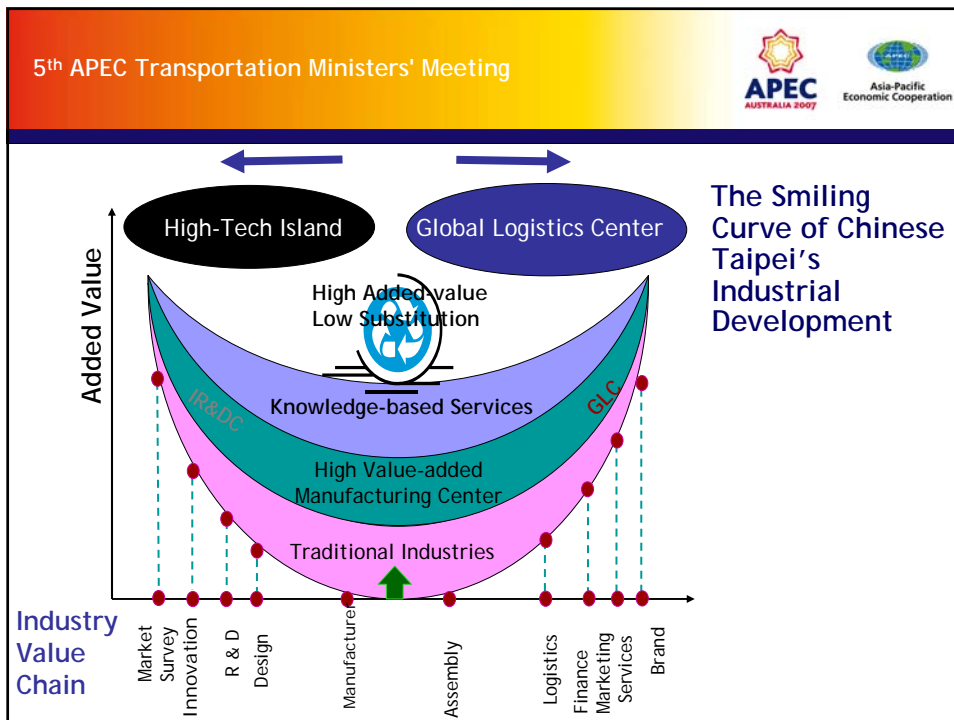
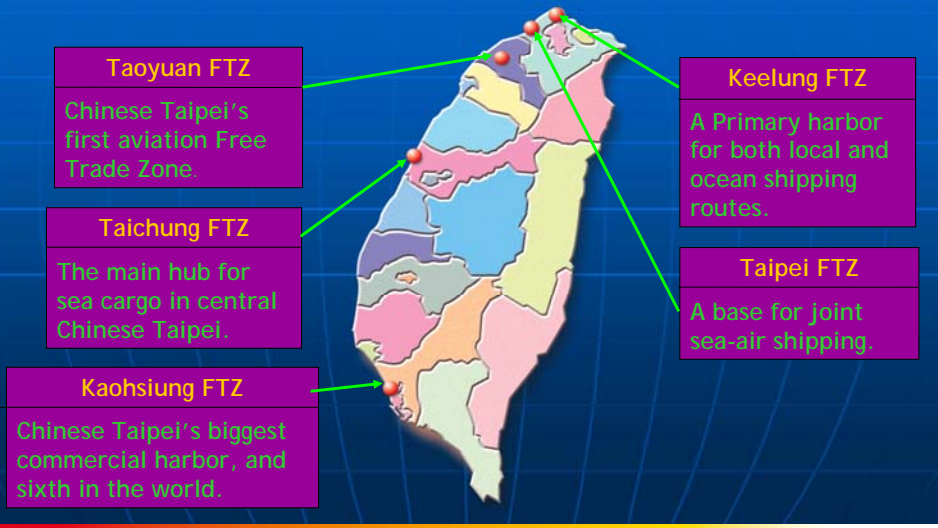

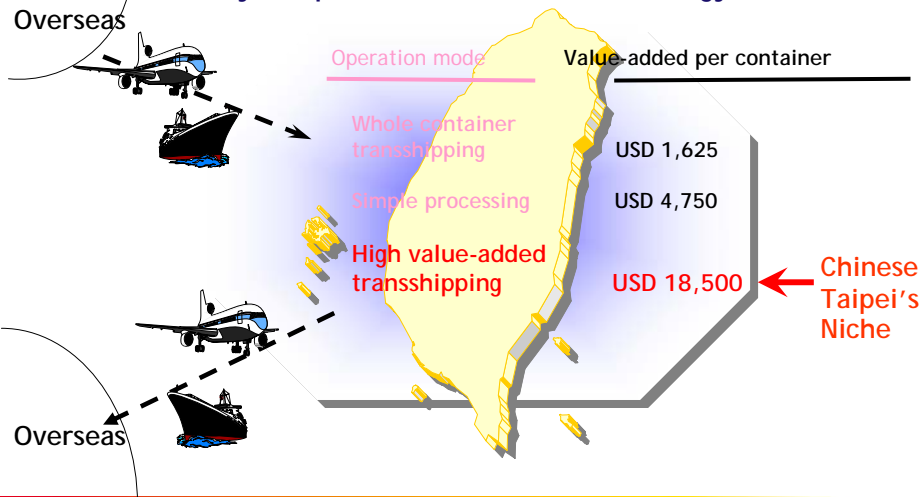
Chinese Taipei's Global Logistics Development Plan
